## 5. Architectural Conservation Area

1. **Annascaul:** Two blocks on Main Street
2. **Ardamore:** Rural townland on Dingle Peninsula
3. **Asdee:** One block -3 plots
4. **Ballylongford:** Four blocks- Bridge St., Bridge St./Quay St., Quay St., / Well St
5. **Brosna:** The Square and block on both sides of Main Street
6. **Caherdaniel:** Two blocks
7. **Cahersiveen:** Centred on Main Street, with extensions on Old Market St. and O'Connell St
8. **Castleisland:** Areas on both sides of Main St. and sections of Church St. and Barrack St
9. **Dingle:** Large areas of town centre not contiguous, including Main St., John St., Dykegate St., The Mall, Green St., Grey Lane, Strand St., Bridge St., Holyground, The Tracks.
10. **Farmers Bridge:** Three structures
11. **Fenit:** Central block
12. **Kenmare:** Large central area encompassing the Square, Henry St., Main St. and Shelbourne St. also section of Market St. and Parnell Place.
13. **Kildurrihy:** Rural townland on Dingle Peninsula
14. **Killorglin:** Large area of town centre incorporating Bridge St., Market St., Main St., Mill Road, Iveragh Road (east end), Langford St. (north end)
15. **Knightstown:** Two blocks- Coastguard St. and Market St.
16. **Knocknagashel:** Central triangle
17. **Milltown:** The Square and block on Main St.
18. **Sneem:** Two Squares
19. **Tarbert:** Two small blocks- Church St. and Listowel road
20. **Waterville:** Two Victorian terraces.
